The next challenge



The Guaraporé (pron: Guah-rah-pow-reh) riverbed in the Amazon region is surrounded by communities of Riverain people, Hispanics, Indigenous tribes, and "Quilombolas" (communities initially founded by fugitive slaves) that struggle with limited access to medical assistance, malnutrition, contamination of natural resources, and a general lack of basics to health and well-being.

THE KALEO INSTITUTE EXISTS TO EMPOWER VOLUNTEERS AND FACILITATE THE ACCESS TO SERVE THESE COMMUNITIES IN THE AMAZON REGION.

The Amazon Saviour 2018 project is organised by Kaleo Institute in partnership with SEEDS Newcastle, with the support and sponsorship of ADRA (Adventist Development and Relief Agency) and the Government of the State of Rondonia. We will count with a group of 30 volunteers, expecting at least 4 dentists and 3 doctors with experience in pediatrics and ophthalmology to assist in specific needs. There will be visits to the communities to assess their needs. In addition to that, we will offer educational sessions in health and lifestyle.

WITHIN 11 DAYS, WE EXPECT TO SERVE UP TO 2,000 FAMILIES, OFFERING FREE MEDICAL, DENTISTRY AND EDUCATIONAL SERVICES AND ASSISTANCE.







The local population is marked by precarious living conditions, with low-to-none sanitation infrastructure, where the fragility caused by abandonment is evident. These factors contribute to high rates of infant mortality and overall poor health conditions in the area.

Currently, we plan to execute this project from May 15 until May 26, starting in the region of Pimenteiras, going through Forte Principe until Guajará Mirim.















SURGERY AND CONSULTATION ROOMS WITH APPLIANCES AND TOOLS



Medical Clinic Ship passing by Guaporé and Mamoré






Amazon Sunset
